





Dear Family,

Congratulations! Welcoming a new child into your family is one of the most exciting and intense experiences, one full of hopes, dreams, and challenges. We are excited to be on this journey with you!

By now, you have learned that your child has a hearing difference. (Some people may use the term hearing loss.) The amazing brains of babies and young children are learning every day. For babies and young children who have hearing differences, the first years of life are an especially critical time for developing language and communication, social connections, and early skills that lead to later learning in school and beyond. There are many people who can support you on your journey: family members and friends, your community, other families of children who have hearing differences, deaf or hard of hearing adults, members of faith communities, and health and education professionals to name a few. We are also here to help you and your child as you grow together.

Help Me Grow Minnesota is a referral system that provides information and resources for families as your child is growing and learning and connects you directly with supports and services when you have worries or concerns about their development. These services, which may be called early intervention services, are free of charge to all eligible children and families through local public school districts and cooperatives across Minnesota and 11 Tribal Nations who share land with us, regardless of family income or immigration status.

Your audiologist and pediatrician are required by law to connect all babies and young children who have hearing differences or other developmental concerns and their families to early intervention and preschool special education services.
